(Oct 1) | *Matthew 5:44*: Love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you. [C]

(Oct 8) | *John 17:22*: “The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one.” [P]

(Oct 15) | *Isaiah 26:4*: Trust in the Lord forever for in God the Lord, we have an everlasting Rock. [C]

(Dec 3) | *Revelation 3:21*: “He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.” [P]

(Dec 10) | *Hebrews 10:23*: Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.” [C]

(Dec 17) | *Philippians 1:6*: He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus. [P]

(Dec 24) | *Jude 1:21*: Keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting anxiously for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life. [C]
