

Memory Verses 2019 (Promises & Commands)

January 6 Zephaniah 3:17 The Lord your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy. [P]

January 13 John 13:34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. [C]

January 20 Jeremiah 3:14-15 I will take you one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion. Then I will give you shepherds after My own heart, who will feed you on knowledge and understanding. [P]

January 27 Hebrews 12:1 Since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us. [C]

February 3 Jeremiah 32:40 I will make an everlasting covenant with them: I will never stop doing good to them, and I will inspire them to fear me, so that they will never turn away from me.* [P]

February 10 I Peter 4:1 Since Christ has suffered in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same purpose, because he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin. [C]

February 17 Jeremiah 31:3-4 I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I have drawn you with lovingkindness. Again I will build you and you will be rebuilt. [P]

February 24 II Peter 3:14 Beloved, since you look for these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, spotless and blameless. [C]

March 3 Hebrews 8:11 - They shall not teach everyone his fellow citizen, and everyone his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for all will know Me, from the least to the greatest of them. [P]

March 10 James 1:26 If anyone thinks himself to be religious, and yet does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this man's religion is worthless. [C]

March 17 Zephaniah 3:10-11 I will remove from your midst your proud, exulting ones, and you will never again be haughty on My holy mountain. But I will leave among you a humble and lowly people, and they will take refuge in the name of the Lord. [P]

March 24 Ephesians 4:2-3 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.* [C]

March 31 2 Peter 1:4 He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust. [P]

April 7 II Corinthians 7:1 Having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. [C]

April 14 Psalm 34:18 The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. [P]

April 21 I Peter 4:10 As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. [C]

April 28 John 1:12 As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name. [P]

May 5 Hebrews 3:13 Encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. [C]

May 12 John 6:37 All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out. [P]

May 19 Colossians 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful. [C]

May 26 Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Him who strengthens me. [P]

June 2 Luke 21:34 Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life, and that day will not come on you suddenly like a trap. [C]

June 9 2 Corinthians 4:17 For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison. [P]

June 16 I Peter 1:13 Prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. [C]

June 23 Psalm 119:32 I shall run the way of Your commandments, for You will enlarge my heart. [P]

June 30 Deuteronomy 10:16 Circumcise your heart, and stiffen your neck no longer. [C]

July 7 Galatians 6:8 The one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. [P]

July 14 Hebrews 2:1 We must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away from it. [C]

July 21 John 3:34 He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure. [P]

July 28 Revelation 3:11 I am coming quickly; hold fast what you have, so that no one will take your crown. [C]

August 4 Isaiah 60:13 I shall make the place of My feet glorious. [P]

August 11 Ephesians 5:14 Awake, sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you. [C]

August 18 Isaiah 54:8 With everlasting lovingkindness I will have compassion on you," says the Lord your Redeemer. [P]

August 25 John 12:36 While you have the Light, believe in the Light, so that you may become sons of Light. [C]

September 1 Hebrews 6:10 God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints. [P]

September 8 Matthew 11:29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. [C]

September 15 James 4:7 Submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. [P]

September 22 Mark 5:36 Do not be afraid any longer, only believe. [C]

September 29 Isaiah 49:15-16 I will not forget you. Behold, I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands; your walls are continually before Me. [P]

October 6 Hebrews 10:24 Let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds. [C]

October 13 Psalm 139:17-18 How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How vast is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would outnumber the sand. [P]

October 20 John 15:8-9 My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples. Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love. [C]

October 27 II Corinthians 9:7-8 God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed. [P]

November 3 I Peter 1:17 If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay on earth. [C]

November 10 Hebrews 7:25 He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. [P]

November 17 Matthew 20:27-28 Whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave; just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many. [C]

November 24 II Timothy 1:7 God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline. [P]

December 1 Acts 20:35 By working hard, you must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He Himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' [C]

December 8 Hebrews 4:12 The word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit.. and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart. [P]

December 15 Hebrews 13:7 Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and considering the result of their conduct, imitate their faith. [C]

December 22 Revelations 22:12 Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done. [P]

December 29 I Peter 4:7-8 The end of all things is near; therefore, be of sound judgment and sober spirit for the purpose of prayer. Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. [C]
