January 5

[PROMISE] John 15:10

"If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love."

January 12

[COMMAND] Romans 12:3

Through the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith.

January 19

[PROMISE] Isaiah 42:16

"I will lead the blind by a way they do not know...

I will make darkness into light before them
And rugged places into plains.
These are the things I will do,
And I will not leave them undone."

January 26

[COMMAND] Deuteronomy 32:46-47

"Take to your heart all the words with which I am warning you today, which you shall command your sons to observe carefully, even all the words of this law. For it is not an idle word for you; indeed it is your life."

February 2

[PROMISE] Isaiah 33:6

And He will be the stability of your times,
A wealth of salvation, wisdom and knowledge;

[COMMAND] John 14:1

February 16

[PROMISE] Psalms 25:14

[COMMAND] Psalm 81:10

April 12

[PROMISE] Acts 26:18

[COMMAND] John 3:21

[PROMISE] Psalms 68:6

[COMMAND] James 1:2-3

[PROMISE] James 1:12

[COMMAND] I Timothy 4:7-8

[PROMISE] II Corinthians 4:13-14

August 9

[COMMAND] Romans 6:11

Consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

August 16

[PROMISE] I Corinthians 11:31-32

If we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world.

August 23

[COMMAND] I Corinthians 13:4-7

Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered, does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

August 30

[PROMISE] Ephesians 1:4-6

He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love, He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace.

September 6

[COMMAND] Psalm 34:8

O taste and see that the Lord is good;
How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him!

September 13

[PROMISE] II Samuel 23:5

"He has made an everlasting covenant with me,
Ordered in all things, and secured;
For all my salvation and all my desire,
Will He not indeed make it grow?"

[COMMAND] II Corinthians 5:9-10

Therefore we also have as our ambition, whether at home or absent, to be pleasing to Him. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

[PROMISE] Malachi 3:3

[COMMAND] I John 5:21

Little children, guard yourselves from idols.

December 6

[PROMISE] I John 2:27

December 13

[COMMAND] Luke 12:36

[PROMISE] I John 3:2
